Build on the foundation

The Bridge Builders course *Mediating Interpersonal Conflicts* teaches a process that can be seen as a basic recipe. It's best to practise it as it stands, at first.

Experience is the key. The best way of learning how to use the process effectively is to keep using it, and to watch others using it. That's why the main training-tool for this workshop is role-play. You face a unique scenario, but the shape of the process remains the same.

Book for this workshop if you're already convinced that mediation can make a valuable difference in the life of the church, and you want to renew your determination to be part of the difference.

This includes training materials, refreshments and a simple buffet lunch.

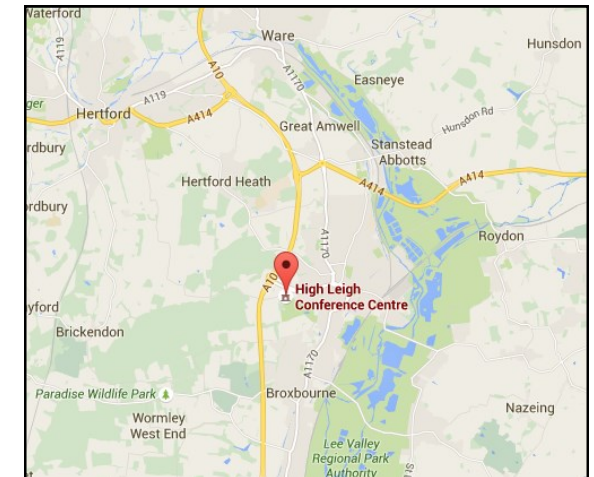
